Pro Niti Travel Sustainable Tourism Goals for the year 2019

- With the help of the **Recyglo**, we are trying Zero Waste in the office at the end of Dec 2019.
- To reduce 5% usage of electricity per month.
- To reduce 10% of electricity bills than the last year.
- To reduce 10% of paper usage at our office than the last year.

Pro Niti Travel General Policy (Internal Management)

The intention of this policy is to make Pro Niti as a greener, more sustainable and more responsible company in the near future.

- Reduce the consumption level of electricity in office whenever possible.
- LED bulbs are installed instead of regular bulbs.



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- Chargers of portable devices are not left in the socket; they continue to consume energy as long as they are connected.
 - Use natural lights as much as possible.
 - Eco-friendly tips and signs are placed on the noticeboard to remind the staffs.

 - We also collect the water which come out from the air-conditioner and use that again in the toilet.
 - We can't set limit upon drinking water because it depends on different biological needs. Although we can't control it, we provide reusable water bottles from 'Refill not Landfill'.
 - Send **Recyglo** to recycle the paper waste and evaluate "Paper waste report" by every month and make implementation for reducing month by month.
 - Whenever printing, avoid color printing. Because color printing generally uses more ink, so print in black and white as much as possible.
 - Try to be more paperless system in office by using Slack and Asana application and file sharing with Google drive and local network.
 - Print both side of the paper sheet.
 - Don't use water for cleaning tasks that can be done with other tools: sweep sidewalks and floors instead of pressure washing them.
 - Every electronics are set the term in the office. For example, we decided to use air-conditioners in the office for 5 years. During 5 years, we won't buy any new air-conditioners. We also apply the same rule for other electronics devices such as computers.
 - For the electronic waste, we sell the old ones and used computers to the local suppliers who reuse and recycle the used electronics devices.
 - Give every tourist reusable bottles or bags.
 - Promote the tourists to buy from local.

Pro Niti Travel General Policy (All Operation Processes)

Pro Niti Travel believes and supports the "three pillars" of sustainable tourism, namely Environmental Sustainability, Economic Sustainability, and Socio-Cultural Sustainability.

- Paying attention to the local benefits of the communities when selecting suppliers and local excursion providers.
- Motivating partners/suppliers/ excursion providers to participate in sustainability practices.
- Training our suppliers/ excursion providers and motivating on the avoidance of sexual exploitation of children.
- Prioritize working with local tour guides, drivers and other necessary providers.
- Prioritize selecting accommodations that employ local communities.
- Ensuring that employees, excursion providers and key suppliers are informed Pro Niti Travel commitment of sustainability.



- Clearly and actively communicating our sustainability objectives and requirements regarding accommodations with our key accommodation suppliers.
- Avoid offering any excursions that harm natural and cultural resources.
- Selecting our key accommodation suppliers that comply with sustainability.
- Ensuring and motivating that our key accommodation suppliers, the rights of children are respected:
- Working with accommodations and restaurants that incorporate local art, cultural heritage and respecting the rights of local communities.
- Ensuring that illegal souvenirs list of Myanmar is informed to the guests.
- Clearly inform our commitment to sustainability to our guests.
- Motivate clients to use local restaurants and other local community owned businesses.
